HISTORY & INDICATION

54-year-old male referred for screening colonoscopy. First-degree family history of colorectal cancer (father, diagnosed at 58). Type 2 diabetes (diet-controlled), former smoker. No previous colonoscopy. No known IBD or polyposis syndrome. No antithrombotic therapy.

PREPARATION & SEDATION

Split-dose PEG preparation. Boston Bowel Preparation Scale 8/9 (right 3, transverse 3, left 2) — adequate. Written informed consent obtained (ASA II). Propofol sedation with continuous monitoring; CO₂ insufflation.

PROCEDURE

The video colonoscope was introduced and advanced to the caecum, confirmed by the appendiceal orifice and ileocaecal valve (photodocumented). The examination was completed without difficulty and the patient tolerated the procedure well. Rectal retroflexion was performed. The terminal ileum was not intubated.

FINDINGS

- Sigmoid colon** — 12 mm flat-elevated polyp (Paris 0-IIa, NICE 2), removed en bloc by hot snare; specimen retrieved (H1).
- Ascending colon** — 4 mm sessile polyp (Paris 0-Is, NICE 2), removed by cold snare; specimen retrieved (H2).
- Descending colon** — focal mucosal erythema, no ulceration; two cold-forceps biopsies taken (H3).
- Sigmoid colon** — scattered uncomplicated diverticula.

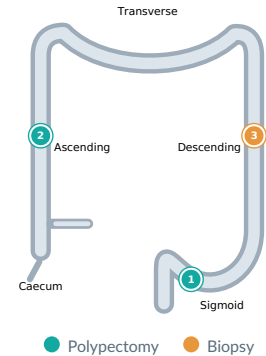
IMPRESSION

- Two colorectal adenomas resected (sigmoid 12 mm; ascending 4 mm) — histology pending.
- Focal erythema, descending colon — biopsied, histology pending.
- Sigmoid diverticulosis, uncomplicated.

RECOMMENDATION

- Await histology results (H1–H3); addendum to follow.
- Surveillance colonoscopy in 3 years** — ESGE post-polypectomy guideline (adenoma ≥ 10 mm). To be confirmed after histology.
- Findings and recommendations discussed with the patient; plain-language patient summary issued.
